2. Aim and results of the seminar

The seminar was organized within the activity planned in Work Package 4. Prof. Aleksander Sladkowski from Silesian University of Technology (Poland) offered lecture for staff and students of Batumi State Maritime Academy. The lecture was dedicated to the toll collection system which is used in the Poland and on this example Prof. Sladkowski demonstrated advantages of the system and the ways it effects logistic system of the country.

In the conclusion, Prof. Sladkowski assumed that introduction of new system of road fees would lead to a temporary financial loss of transport enterprises. One method of solving this problem for companies is to invest in new vehicles or comparatively not old, which are responsible EURO5 standard and this should contribute into improvement of environmental situation on the roads.

The topic was welcomed by the staff and students of BSMA. Lecture was conducted in interactive manner. Students and staff had chance to ask questions. The road situation in Georgia is requiring serious reforms. As a transit country this infrastructure is of high importance. BSMA staff describes existing situation in Georgia to Prof Sladkowski and had intensive discussions on possibilities of improvement in logistics system of Georgia.

Sum up of the seminar

The seminar of Prof. Sladkowski was very useful experience for BSMA staff and students. It was first lecture delivered by EU university representative on such topic. The format was very good and positively accessed by attendees. This kind of contribution to partner universities is essential for the development of staff and quality of education. This will have the most positive outcomes for BSMA

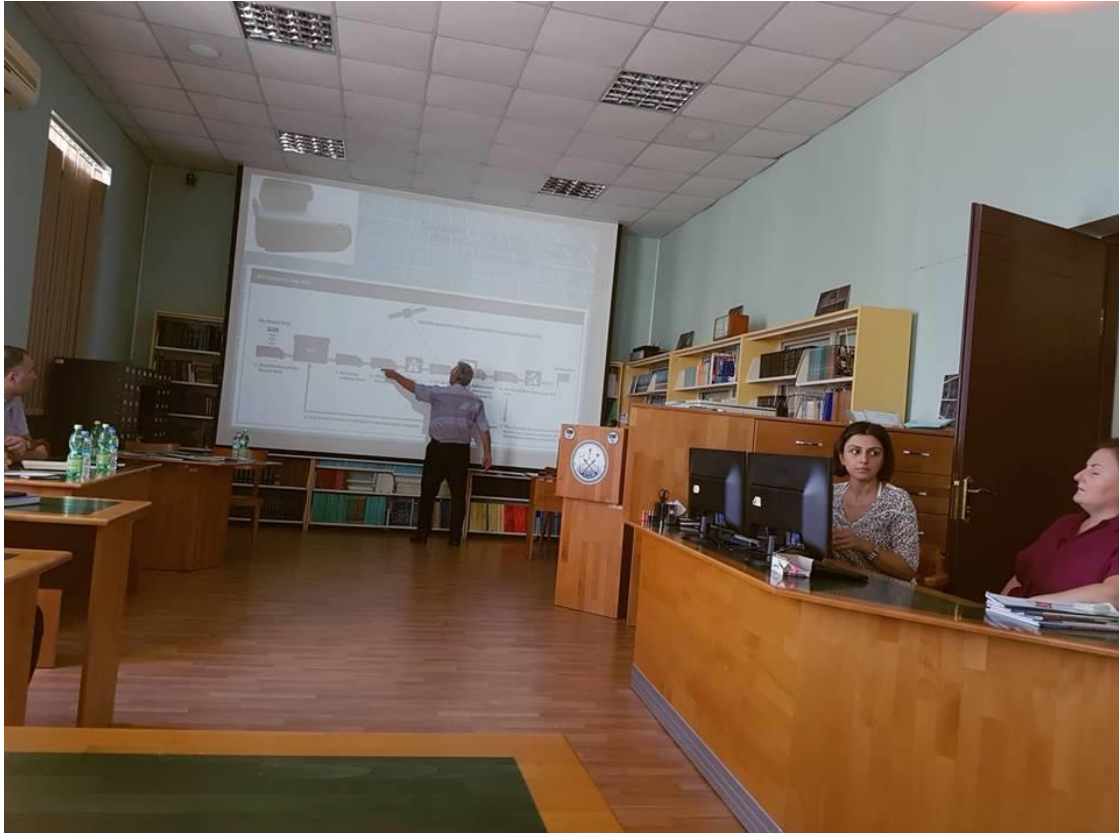
