HOW TO REACH THE SAPIENZA UNIVERSITY

The meeting place is CTL offices, located at the 5th floor of the Engineering Faculty of the University of Rome “La Sapienza” located in via Eudossiana 18.

The Faculty is close to the stop “Colosseo” of Metro Line B.

We suggest entering from the secondary entrance located in Largo della Polveriera 19.

Cross the gate in front of you and take the external iron lift on the left up to the 5th floor.

(If you arrive from Colosseo metro station, in the hall’s station don’t exit on via dei Fori Imperiali, but take the passage on your right where there is an escalator that goes over the station. You will exit on a terrace (a small square) in front of Colosseo (nice sight from there).

Behind the Metro exit there is a pedestrian bridge, cross it and go straight on “Via della Polveriera” for about 200 m. You will arrive in front of the secondary entrance of Engineering Faculty.)
