The procedure for reimbursement of mobility within the SMS will be performed as follows:

- the coordinator will transfer money to each partner according to the forecast of SMS mobility and budget received from EACEA;
- the sending institutions will develop all the activities foreseen by SMS guidelines and are responsible for this activity;
- the sending institutions will provide the money anticipation (and finally the settlement) to participants in mobility;
- the sending institutions and participants in mobility provide to the coordinator the documents for mobility tool and financial balance.
- Once, all documents will be received, the coordinator will reimburse the remaining money
 according to the amount transferred by EACEA.

Therefore, the travel plan (planned and agreed with receiving institutions) should be communicated to the coordinator together with an estimation of budget. Then, the two parts (sending institution and coordinator) can agree the first money transfer respecting the limits of available budget and the second money transfer after mandatory documents are consigned.




The mobility grant agreements must be signed by the **Participant in the mobility** (the student or the staff member) and the **Sending institution**, independently of this institution is situated in a Programme or in a Partner country. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

ARTICLE-1 -- SUBJECT MATTER-OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1.1 → The institution shall-provide support to the participant for undertaking a mobility activity for training under the Erasmus+Programme. ¶
- 1.2 The participant accepts the financial support or the provision of services as specified in article 3 and undertakes to carry out the mobility activity for training as described in Annex I.¶
- 1.3.→ Amendments to the agreement shall be requested and agreed by both parties through a formal notification by letter or by electronic message. ¶

ARTICLE-2-ENTRY-INTO-FORCE-AND-DURATION-OF-MOBILITY¶

- 2.1 → The agreement shall enter into force on the date when the last of the two parties signs.¶
- 2.2 → The mobility period shall start on 20/05/2019 and end on 1/07/2019. ¶
 The start date of the mobility period shall be the first day that the participant needs to be present at the receiving institution and the end date shall be the last day the participant needs to be present at the receiving institution. ¶
 - One-day-for-travel-before-the-first-day-of-the-activity-abroad-and-one-day-for-travel-following-the-last-dayof-the-activity-abroad-shall-be-added-to-the-duration-of-the-mobility-period-and-included-in-the-calculationfor-individual-support.¶
- 2.3 → The participant shall receive financial support from Erasmus+EU funds for 43 days of activity and 2 days for travel.¶
- 2.4 The total duration of the mobility period shall not exceed 2 months, with a minimum of 5 days permobility activity. A minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week has to be respected. ¶

 For any additional incomplete week, the minimum number of teaching hours per extra day is calculated as: 8 hours divided by 5, multiplied by the number of extra days. ¶
- 2.5 The participant may submit any request-concerning the extension of the mobility period within the limit-set out in article 2.4. If the institution agrees to extend the duration of the originally planned mobility period, the agreement shall be amended accordingly. ¶
- 2.6 → The Certificate of Attendance shall provide the effective start and end dates of the mobility period. ¶

ARTICLE-3 - FINANCIAL-SUPPORT¶

- 3.1. The participant shall receive 4998 EUR corresponding to individual support and 275 EUR corresponding to travel from the institution. The amount of individual support is 140 EUR per day up to the 14th day of activity and 98 EUR per day from the 15th day. The final amount for the mobility period shall be determined by multiplying the number of days of the mobility specified in article 2.3 with the individual support rate applicable per day for the receiving country and adding the contribution for travel to the amount obtained.
- The procedure for reimbursement of mobility within the SMS will be performed as follows: ¶
 - •• the coordinator of the Master in SMArt transport and LOGistics for cities / SMALOG project (585832-EPP-1-2017-1-IT-EPPKA2-CBHE-IP (2017-2893/001-001)) UNIVERSITA DEGLI STUDI DI ROMA TOR VERGATA [UNITOV] will transfer money to the institution to the forecast of SMS mobility and budget received from EACEA.
 - -- the institutions will develop all the activities foreseen by SMS guidelines and are responsible for this activity.
 - --- the institutions will provide the money anticipation (and finally the settlement) to participants in mobility.
 - the institutions and participants in mobility provide to the coordinator [UNITOV] the documents for mobility tool and financial balance. ¶
 - —documents will-be-received, the coordinator—[UNITOV]—will-reimburse the remaining money according to the amount transferred by EACEA.
- 3.2 → The financial support may not be used to cover costs already funded by other EU funds. ¶
- 3.3 → Notwithstanding Article 3.2, the financial support is compatible with any other source of funding.¶
- 3.4 The financial support or part of it shall be recovered if the participant does not carry out the mobility activity in compliance with the terms of the agreement. However, reimbursement shall not be requested when the participant has been prevented from completing his/her mobility activities as described in Annex I due to force majeure. Such cases shall be reported by the institution to the Agency. ¶

ARTICLE 4 - PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

4.1 → Within 30-calendar-days-following the signature of the agreement by both parties, and no later than the start date of the mobility period, a pre-financing payment of 4218.4 EUR (80%) shall be made to the participant by the institution. ¶



- 4.2 If payment under Article 4.1 is lower than 100% of the financial support, the submission of the online EU Survey shall be considered as the participant's request for payment of the balance of the financial support from Erasmus+ EU funds. The institution shall have 45 calendar days to make the balance payment or to issue a recovery order in case a reimbursement is due.
- 4.3 The participant must provide proof of the actual dates of start and end of the mobility period, based on a certificate of attendance provided by the receiving organisation.

ARTICLE 5 - EU SURVEY: PARTICIPANT REPORT

- 5.1. The participant shall complete and submit the online EU Survey after the mobility abroad within 30 calendar days upon receipt of the invitation to complete it.
- 5.2 Participants who fail to complete and submit the online EU Survey may be required to partially or fully reimburse the financial support received.

ARTICLE 6 - INSURANCE

- 6.1 The participant shall have adequate insurance coverage.
- 6.2 Acknowledgement that health insurance coverage has been organised shall be included in this agreement.

ARTICLE 7 - LAW APPLICABLE AND COMPETENT COURT

- 7.1 The Agreement is governed by the national law of Ukraine taking in to consideration the Erasmus+Brogganupe Guide, the Guidelines for the Use of the Grant and in the Guidelines for the Special Mobility Strand, for grants awarded in 2017 under the call for proposals EACEA-A03-2016 and regulation documents of Smglog project (Grant Agreement No. «2017 2893 / 001 001 », Partnership Agreement (585832-EPP-1-2017-1-IT-EPPK A2-CBHE-JP (2017-2893 001-001).
- 7.2 The competent court determined in accordance with the applicable national law shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute between the institution and the participant concerning the interpretation, application or validity of this Agreement, if such dispute cannot be settled amicably.




